

## British Values - Years 5 and 6 (2018-2019)



Promoting Fundamental British Values as Part of SMSC in Schools, pupils should have understanding and knowledge that includes:

- How citizens can influence decision-making through the **democrati**c process.
- An appreciation that living under the **rule of law** protects individual citizens and is essential for their wellbeing and safety.
- An understanding that there is a separation of power between the executive and the judiciary, and that while some public bodies such as the police and the army can be held to account through **Parliament**, others such as the **courts** maintain independence.
- An understanding that the freedom to choose and hold other faiths and beliefs is protected in law.
- An acceptance that other people have different faiths or beliefs to oneself (or having none) should be accepted and tolerated, and should not be the cause of prejudicial or discriminatory behaviour.
- An understanding of the importance of identifying and combatting discrimination.
