

Attainment and progress for the academic year 2018-19 Corsham Regis Primary Academy



54% of pupils achieved a **Good Level of Development** in Foundation Stage

82% of pupils passed the **Year 1 Phonics** screening test (National average 82%)

At the end of **Key Stage 1**:

- 70% of Year 2 achieved the expected standard in Reading or above, and 15% are working in greater depth
- 70% of Year 2 achieved the expected standard in Writing or above, and 10% are working in greater depth
- 70% of Year 2 achieved the expected standard in Mathematics or above, and 15% are working in greater depth
- 65% of Year 2 achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Mathematics

At the end of Key Stage 2:

- 50% of Year 6 achieved the expected standard in Reading (National average was 73%) and 8% the greater depth standard (National average was 27%)
- 63% of Year 6 achieved the expected standard in Writing (National average was 78%)
- 42% of Year 6 achieved the expected standard in EGPS (National average was 78%) and 4% the greater depth standard (National average was 36%)
- 54% of Year 6 achieved the expected standard in Mathematics (National average was 79%) and 8% the greater depth standard (National average was 27%)
- 38% of Year 6 achieved the expected standard in Reading and Mathematics and Writing

The average scaled scores for the end of Key Stage 2 are:



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- Reading 99.7
- EGPS 98.3
- Mathematics 100

The progress measures for the end of Key Stage 2 are:

- Reading -4.9
- Writing -4.4
- Mathematics -4.5
