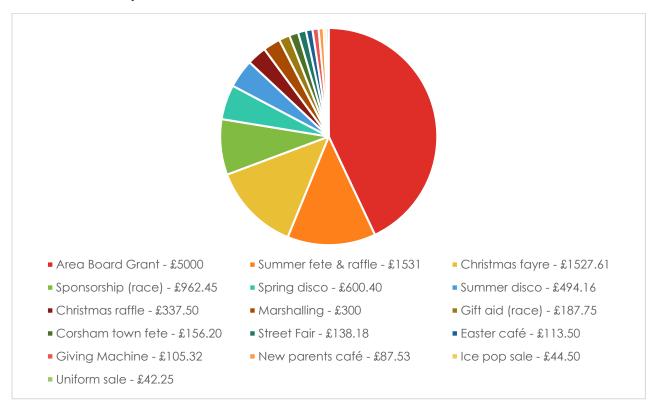

OUR SCHOOL, OUR COMMUNITY...

Friends of Regis' secondary purpose is to enhance community spirit within the school and our town. Examples include organising Christmas parties with visit from Father Christmas, taking part in Corsham Street Fair and Town Fete, organising a café for new parents, representing Team Regis and providing marshals at Corsham 2K/10K races and bringing together families and staff at our Christmas Favre and Summer Fete.

Where our money came from

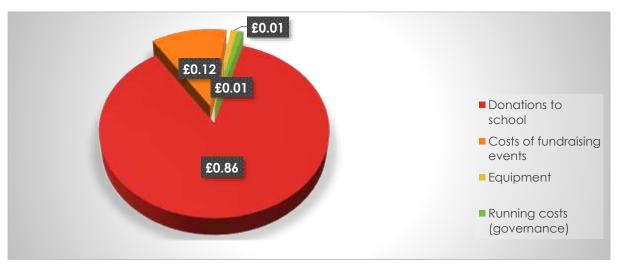


We became a registered charity in January 2018 due to our income exceeding £5,000. We can now claim gift aid, which increased our 2K/10K sponsorship to a total of £1,150.20 and we continue to investigate other sources of charitable income.

We donated £10,687 to our school: Here's how the donations were used

Our largest single donation of £7,500 towards KS1 play equipment included £5,000 grant income from Corsham Area Board which was matched by £2,500 from our fundraising and a further £2,500 from the school budget. The remaining £3,187 of our donations included work supporting children's mental wellbeing and readiness to learn, sports kit, craft resources and creating special memories including a theatre visit, Christmas activities and leavers gifts/celebrations.
