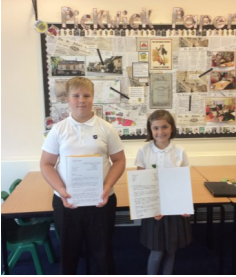

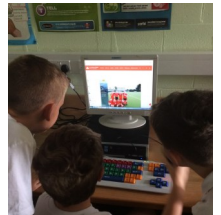


Jade Class have been super stars this week and very busy!
