Congratulations to our Year 5 & 6 Netball Team. Having never played the game before, they finished as Runners Up in the Corsham Cluster competition last week.



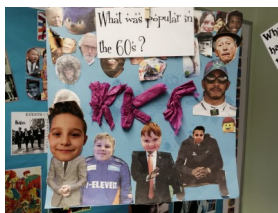
In **Onyx Class**, the children have produced these wonderful clay tiles and carefully inscribed their own designs using different tools to do so. We think they look really effective.

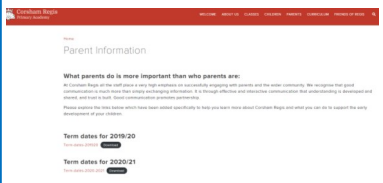
This is the percentage of pupils who must achieve the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths in July 2020
