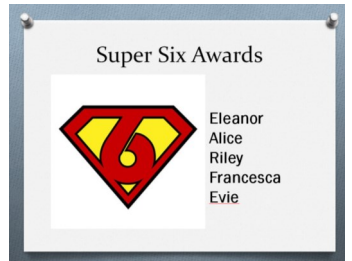

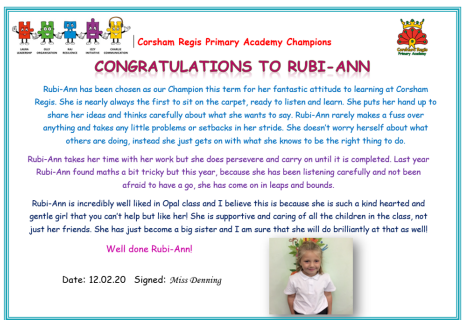

Kara is a very resourceful and creative learner and uses her initiative well. She has displayed this well during our recent topic on the 1970's.

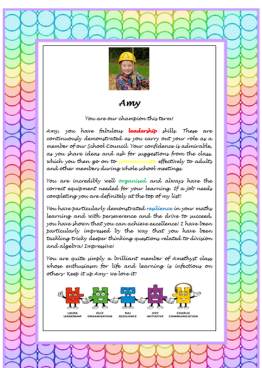
Kara is a kind and gentle member of the class and we really love Kara being part of the Crystal team.

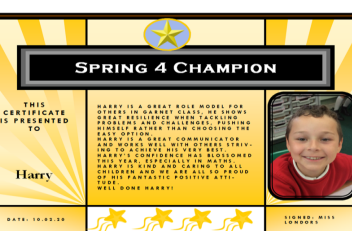
This is the percentage of pupils who must achieve the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths in July 2020
