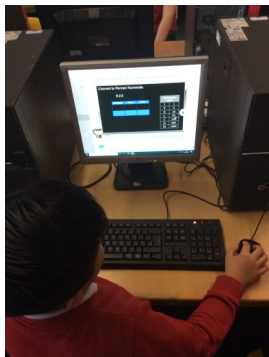


Don't pick me Miss!

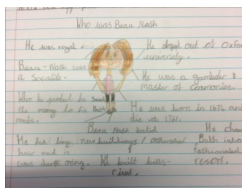
