



School Closure Daily Planning- **Opal** Class

Use the lines to as a starting point to create your own artwork (be as creative as you like!)</p>  <p>Squiggle drawing</p> | <p>Continue with your school reading book.</p> <p>Draw a picture of your favourite part of your book.</p> <p>Explain to an adult what happens in your favourite part and why it is your favourite part.</p> | <p>Write your second paragraph on houses in the Iron Age/Metal Ages.</p> <p>Make sure to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subheading • Factual vocab • Connectives • Punctuation • Re-read to check it | <p>Multiplication</p> <p>Roll a dice and multiply the numbers together.</p> <p>Draw arrays to help you. e.g. $5 \times 3 = 15$</p>  <p>Use this website if you</p> | <p>Create cave paintings of woolly mammoths and cave men hunsting with your hands and a material that you find around your house (e.g. cocoa powder/spices /mud!)</p> |
