If you have finished it then re-read the start of it to someone and try to use good fluency and expression – look carefully at the punctuation to help you.</p> <p>Use a dictionary to look up the meaning of two or three words that you are not sure the meaning of. There are online dictionaries if you don't have one at home.</p>	<p>Try finish your story today based on "The Tunnel" today.</p> <p>Make sure you have used lots of description when you get to the part where they are in a new place at the other end of the tunnel. Maybe you can use a simile where you use "as" or "like" (It was as dark as the night. It was green like grass.)</p> <p>Try to use conjunctions to extend your sentences and remember to use a new paragraph to show a new part of the story, to show that the characters are in a new place, or to show that some time has passed.
