Tuesday 24 th March	<p>Carry on reading your book for around 15 minutes.</p> <p>Write down something you have found out – either a new fact or something you have found out about a character in the book. You could draw a picture of the character and surround the picture with things you have found out about them and their characteristics.</p>	<p>Start planning for a story based on the story we read in class called "The Tunnel". In the book the brother and sister (who are so very different in how they look and behave) are sent out by their mother. They go to some waste ground and find a tunnel which leads to a deep, dark forest. The girl has to rescue the boy, who went first and was turned to stone.</p> <p>Think of where the tunnel might lead in your story- maybe a desert, or outer space, or somewhere snowy? Let your imagination run wild! Draw a picture of the place you have chosen and surround it with descriptions of the place (adjectives). Draw what will happen to the boy and how his sister will rescue him.</p>	<p>Write out all the number bonds to 10 -</p> <p>$1+9=10$, $2+8=10$ and so on.</p> <p>If you find this easy and complete it quickly then you could then write the number bonds to 20-</p> <p>$1 + 19 = 20$ $2 + 18 = 20$ and so on.</p> <p>The chilli challenge today is to write the number bonds to 100 using multiples of 10 –</p> <p>$10 + 90 = 100$ $20 + 80 = 100$</p>	<p>Create a poster that could have been used in World War II to encourage people to grow their own vegetables.</p> <p>Make it bright, eye-catching and try to include a catchy slogan.</p>
