<p>Morning Activity:</p> <p>Today is the start of Ramadan – can you find out what this is?</p> <p>There is a lovely story on Twinkl called <i>Rameena's Ramadan</i> which the children can read as either an e-book, Powerpoint or audiobook.</p>	<p>Continue with/re-read your book from yesterday.</p> <p>Can identify any words where an apostrophe has been used to combine two words (apostrophe for omission). E.g. didn't don't can't</p> <p>Write these out in a list.</p> <p>What two words have been combined? E.g. didn't – did not</p> <p>If you can't find any – try these: <i>can't shouldn't don't could've hadn't</i></p>	<p>Pretend that you are a sailor on your way back from the 'New World' with Columbus. Write a message in a bottle explaining what your adventure has been like. Try to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What you have been eating • What the weather was like when you landed • Where you have been sleeping • How you felt when you finally saw land • What you think you have discovered • What new foods you have tasted <p>Challenge: can you use an exclamation mark?</p>
