You do not need to print this off, you can just talk through it together or your child can write down the answers in their workbook.</p> <p>***Please note that Year 1's do not need to learn 1/3s until next year so they can have a go at the <i>Fractions Reasoning Problems</i> on the class webpage. Again, you do not need to print it off – just talking through it and showing their working in their book.</p> <p>If your child is in Year 2 but is struggling with 1/2s and 1/4s, they too can have a go at these problems before moving onto 1/3s***</p>	<p>Continue your ship building project.</p> <p>Remember, ships need to be watertight, able to float and stay upright, as well as carry loads.</p> <p>See if you can test your boat to see if it can do these things.</p> <p>Can you measure how much weight your ship can carry?</p>
