


Milne</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Halfway down the stairs Is a stair Where I sit. There isn't any Other stair Quite like It. I'm not at the bottom, I'm not at the top; So this is the stair Where I always Stop.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Halfway up the stairs Isn't up, And isn't down. It isn't in the nursery, It isn't in the town. And all sorts of funny thoughts Run round my head: "It isn't really Anywhere! It's somewhere else Instead!"</p> </div> <p>Do you have a favourite place to be in your home? Where is it? Why do you like it? How do you feel when you are in this place? </p> <p>Can you put it into a short poem like AA Milne, or can you draw a picture of you there with a feelings bubble to illustrate your emotions.</p>	<p>Have a go at this lesson on active and Passive sentences.</p> <p>We started learning about these in the Spring and you were really getting the hang of it, so after this lesson you should all be experts!!
