<p>Monday 1st June</p>	<p>Today you will be learning about Christianity.</p> <p>Key questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is the best way for a Christian to show commitment to God? • Do religious people lead better lives? • Does participating in worship help people to feel closer to God or their faith community? <p>There is a story called 'The Hiding Place' by Corrie Ten-Boom where one Christian woman decided to lie to the German soldier about Jews that she was hiding. This meant the Jews were safe.</p> <p>Her sister, another Christian woman, felt that she could not lie and this resulted in the Jews being arrested.</p> <p>However, the Jews later escaped. The woman believed that God would keep this woman safe due to her commitment to the truth.</p> <p>What would they have done?</p> <p>Is telling lies always wrong?</p>	<p>Christians are committed to God and show their commitment in different ways. One way is through following the Ten Commandments, one of which is 'do not lie'.</p> <p>Look at Ten Commandments (Exodus 20:2-17) Order them according to which ones you think show most commitment to God.</p> <p>Ten Commandments for Kids (Exodus 20:1-17)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Have no other gods but God. 2. Do not worship statues. 3. Be careful with God's name. 4. Keep the Sabbath day special. 5. Honor your father and mother. 6. Do not murder. 7. Keep your marriage promises. 8. Do not steal. 9. Do not lie. 10. Do not covet. <p>Are any easier to follow? Why? Why do we have different views about which are more or less important than others?</p> <p>Look at Galatians 5:14 which states 'love thy neighbour as yourself'. What does this mean? Who is 'your neighbour'? How easy do you think it is for Christians to do this?</p>	<p>You will need to have x10 post-its/slips of paper. 	<p>How committed would you have been to telling the truth?</p> <p>Would that have been more important than saving someone's life?</p> <p>Which ways have we learnt that a Christian shows their commitment to God?</p>	<p>Galatians 5 - ICB</p> <p>1 We have freedom now because Christ made us free. So stand strong. Do not change and go back into the slavery of the law. 2 Listen! I am Paul. I tell you that if you go back to the law by being circumcised, then Christ is no good for you. 3 Again, I warn every man: If you allow yourselves to be circumcised, then you must follow all the law. 4 If you try to be made right with God through the law, then your life with Christ is over—you have left God's grace. 5 But we hope to be made right with God through faith, and we wait for this hope anxiously with the Spirit's help. 6 When we are in Christ Jesus, it is not important if we are circumcised or not. The important thing is faith—the kind of faith that works through love.</p> <p>Look at Galatians 5:22-26 which states</p> <p>that if a Christian is committed to God and allows the holy spirit to live in them, they will be displaying love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control and not jealousy or conceitedness.</p> <p><small>Galatians 5:22-26 New International Version (NIV)</small></p> <p><small>²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. ²⁴ Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other.</small></p> <p>Under each word write examples of what each might look like. Should only Christians try to behave in these ways? Are these behaviours that everyone should try to display? Explore ideas. How easy is this to do? When would it be hard/easy?
