



<b>Monday</b> <b>4.5.20</b>	<p>Read the Mayan gods. See attachment.</p> <p><b>The Maya Gods</b></p> <p>The Maya had many gods (over 150!); however, only a few are mentioned by the same name in different sources. Some had human form, some took the form of an animal and others were a natural phenomenon. Why do you think the Maya believed most people went to the Underworld after they died?</li> </ol>	<p>Mathletics – your choice</p>	<p>PE – Athletics</p> <p><b>How Far can you run in Two Minutes?</b> Set up a distance of 50m with two markers.</p> <p>Jog back and forth between the two markers and count how many lengths you run in two minutes, trying to stay at a continuous pace. After you have run, calculate the distance you covered by multiplying the number of lengths run by 50. This will give you a distance in metres.</p> <p>Remember to be aware of your <b>breathing</b>, your <b>legs</b> and your overall <b>feeling</b>.</p>
