When parenting + teaching feels too heavy, drop the assignment and snuggle up to read together.



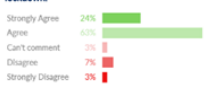

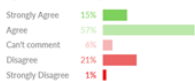
Question 01

My child is able to complete all of the home learning set by the class teacher.



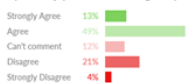
Question 04
My child and I receive feedback from the class teacher about the home learning they have completed.



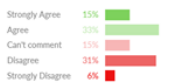
Question 05
