

Then click on another one. If the two cards match, they will stay face-up. If the two cards do not match, they will return to being face-down. 		<p>I have written the beginning of a possible diary entry to help get you started if you need it.</p>	<p>Can you remember where particular cards are to help you match the pairs?</p> <p>The printable cards may help before going on to the interactive activity.</p> <p><u>Extension –follow the links to:</u> <u>Play with a scoring system</u> - you start with 100 points, lose 10 points whenever you turn over cards that don't match, and add 50 points whenever they do match.</p> <p><u>Play against the clock</u> - can you beat your personal best?</p> <p><u>Play with face-up cards</u> - the cards are all face-up at the start so you can focus on the maths rather than the memory aspect of the game.</p>	<p>Can you design a poster to explain to people how to be safe in the sun?
