| Friday<br>26 <sup>th</sup><br>June | <p><b>Operation – get a Blue Peter Badge</b></p> <p>A <b>Blue Peter badge</b> is an award for <a href="#">Blue Peter</a> viewers, given by the <a href="#">BBC</a> children's <a href="#">television programme</a> for those appearing on the show, or in recognition of achievement. They are awarded to children aged 6 to 15, or to adults who have been guests on the programme.<sup>[1]</sup> Approximately 22,000 are distributed annually.<sup>[2]</sup></p> <p>The badges were introduced to the programme by editor <a href="#">Biddy Baxter</a> in 1963, from an idea by <i>Blue Peter</i> producer <a href="#">Edward Barnes</a>. Except for the "Gold" badge and the pre-2005 "Competition Winners' Badge", the badges are in the shape of a shield containing the Blue Peter ship logo, designed by <a href="#">Tony Hart</a>.</p> <p>The badge provides the wearer with free entry to many British attractions, particularly museums and exhibitions that are featured on the show<sup>[3]</sup> although many of the attractions will only allow one badge holder for each full price paying adult.
