Test your knowledge of multiples with the fun game Coconut Multiples from Top Marks!</p> <p>FS2- Counting in 2's- The seagulls in the story of 'The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch' all have two feet. See if you can find out how many feet there are altogether on each wire (see attachment). Remember to counting in 2's.</p>	<p>YR1/ FS2- ICT- Create an underwater scene on Scratch. https://scratch.mit.edu/projects/21924949/ Try to add sprites (characters) and change the background.</p>
