What have you found? Have a go at drawing your friend and write some simple sentences about why they are your friend. Think carefully about where to start and finish each letter.</p>	<p>YR1- Go through the slides on o'clock times (see attachment). Can you create your own daily timetable using o'clock times?</p> <p>If you can, have a go at the <i>Activity Sheet – Telling Time to the Hour</i> on (see attachment).</p> <p>FS2-Count forwards and backwards to 30. Then have a go at writing numbers to 30 in order. Did you get all the numbers the right way round?</p>	<p>YR1- ICT- Choose an animal group to research on child friendly search engine Swiggle (and visual search engine Kiddle). If possible, copy and paste the information onto a Word or Powerpoint file – or write down what you've found out into your workbook. This is a good opportunity to talk to your child about staying safe online when searching for things.</p> <p>FS2- Counting and number recognition https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/underwater-counting Have a go at counting the creatures and finding the matching number.
