<p>Thursday 04.06.20</p> <p>YR1-Write out your chosen common exception spellings in rainbow writing.</p> <p>FS2- spell out some simple cvc words in rainbow writing.</p>	<p>YR1- Can you work out what these words mean and draw a picture for each one?</p> <p>Pail Flock Tale Stool</p> <p>FS2- Read your reading book to an adult or practice putting your sounds together to read simple words.</p> <p>Phonics: https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCo7fbLgY2oA_cFCIg9GdxtQ</p>	<p>YR1- Draw your favourite part from the book and write down what happens in it.</p> <p>FS2- Have a look at the pictures (see attachment) can you use your sounds to label each mini beast?</p>	<p>YR1- Do you know what a half turn looks like?</p> <p>Choose a teddy or toy and give them a starting position. Can you make them do a half turn? Which direction are they facing now?</p> <p>Can you draw this shape after completing a half turn? (cut out a shape to help you if you need to)</p>  <p>Do you know what a quarter turn is?</p> <p>Practise turning your teddy/toy a quarter turn (either way). How many quarters make a whole? How many quarters make a half?</p> <p>FS2- Play shops- find some toys around your house and ask someone at home to either be the shop keeper or the customer. Make some price labels for your toys and see if you can give the right money or give change.</p>	<p>YR1- Science-</p> <p>Watch BBC Bitesize KS1 Is it Alive? Videos.</p> <p>Create a table of things that are dead, things that are alive and things that have never been alive.</p> <p>E.g.</p> <p>A leaf on the ground is dead.</p> <p>A tree is alive.</p> <p>A brick has never been alive.</p> <p>FS2- Look outside, what can you see? Can you go hunting for mini beasts?</p> <p>Draw a picture of everything you find out side.</p>
