What is the little blue fish saying to the rainbow fish?</p>  <p>Have a go at writing a speech bubble for the little blue fish. <b>Extension:</b> Can you also write one for the Rainbow fish?</p>	<p><b>YR1</b>- Go through the slides on <b>half past times</b> (see attachment). Then have a go at the <i>half past times worksheet</i> (see attachment) – can you read the times for Cinderella? For more practise, have a go at telling the time on a clock or watch at home!</p> <p><b>FS2</b>- Careful counting- look at the pictures of the Rainbow Fish (see attachment) and ask someone at home to help you read which colour scales you are counting. Carefully count the scales and write the number below. If you cannot print the attachment out just write the number in your learning book.</p>	<p><b>PE</b>-warm up- join in with some go noddle activities. <a href="https://www.gonoodle.com/">https://www.gonoodle.com/</a></p> <p>Gymnastics- can you stretch up, high as tall as you can, then curl yourself up as small as you can, then stretch out as wide as you can. This week we are looking at jumping. Look at the slide below and see if you can have a go at the 4 basic jumps. <b>Remember when jumping you need to land with your knees bent.</b></p>
