Don't worry if you don't manage all 26! FS2- After watching the story of 'The Rainbow Fish', look at the pictures (see attachment) and put the pictures in order. Can you write any key words down? 	 YR1- Recap on what half past and o'clock times are by having a go at the White Rose o'clock and half past worksheet (see attachment). If you don't have a printer, just talk through each question with an adult or sibling. FS2- Careful counting and adding- look at the Under the sea I spy worksheet (see attachment). Follow the instructions and carefully count the fish and add the correct ones together. If you cannot print the attachment out just write the number in your learning book. 	 YR1- Science- Go through the slides on animal diets (see attachment) – what are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. What are humans? Read the sorting cards (What do I eat?) and create a venn diagram to sort the animals by their diet. Topic- The seashore and under the sea- Have a go at researching information about sea creatures. Maybe you could find out about anchored or moving creatures. Ask an adult to write down anything you find out.
