<p>Read the report about teeth again.</p> <p>I think the title is a bit boring! Can you make it sound more interesting? You could use alliteration (where you use words that start with the same sound) or just create a title that sounds a bit more interesting.</p> <p>Write or draw your new title to make it look as eye-catching and attractive as possible – you could use bubble writing or make up the letters using toothpaste tubes or toothbrushes or even teeth!</p> <p>Ideas for new titles -  <b>Terrific teeth</b>  <b>Our amazing, snappy teeth</b>                      (I don't mind if you want to use one of my ideas).</p>	<p>Verbs are “doing words” - they tell us what someone is doing. Past tense verbs tell us that something has already been done – they often (but not always) end in “ed”:</p> <p>I <b>washed</b> the dirty dishes.                      She <b>painted</b> a pretty picture.                      They <b>watched</b> an amazing film.</p> <p>Complete the verb worksheet where you have to spot the verbs in the sentences and then rewrite them using more interesting (WOW!) verbs. If you want a challenge, see if you can extend the whole sentence.
