Dear Parents and Carers

I wanted to write to you about recent news on primary classes announced by the government.

As you know we have been open for key worker children throughout COVID-19 and then from 1 June we started to welcome back Reception, Year 1 and Year 6.

To those families who are in these year groups can I say thank you for your care in keeping to the safe distancing measures we have put in place. For those with children working from home I want to say thank you for all your work with your child or children to keep them studying – please keep up the good work.

Last week the government announced they would not expect primary schools to reopen for all year groups for one month before the end of term. Instead, where schools had space after providing for the year groups already attending, they could have flexibility to welcome other year groups in before the end of term.

The most important aspect is to maintain the safety measures we have already put in place and to prioritise those who are vulnerable or children of key workers and the year groups the government has already agreed should attend .

With this in mind and considering previous rationale from the government that our youngest pupils should return to school to focus on reading and core subject skills, we have made provision for Year 2 to return for the remaining weeks of term on a part-time basis. Clearly, we want to welcome all pupils back as soon as possible, however at the moment this is just not achievable.

Thank you again to all of you for your patience and resilience at these unusual times. We value your support and look forward to being in touch again soon.
