How do you like to cause mischief?</p> <p>YR1-Draw a picture of how you cause mischief. Write a sentence underneath explaining what you are doing. Remember to use full stops, capital letters and finger spaces.</p> <p>FS2- Draw a picture of how you cause mischief. Write all the sounds you can hear in words when explaining what you are doing. (adults you can annotate underneath if you would like to). Think carefully about where to start and finish each letter.</p>	<p>YR1- Count forwards and backwards to 40. Stand in a space and pretend you are standing on a number line. Stand on number 5 and jump on 2 numbers (2 jumps) where have you landed? $5 + 2 = \underline{\quad}$ Stand on 7 and jump on 3? Stand on 10 and jump on 4? Where do you land each time? Can you make some of your own up?</p> <p>FS2- Count forwards and backwards to 15. Can you choose a number and carefully count out objects to match the number?</p>	<p>Go for a walk outside with an adult and collect natural objects i.e. sticks, leaves, stones, grass and acorns. Can you create your own wild thing monster?</p>
