You can check by measuring it. Can you find 6 objects the same size.</p>	 <p>YR1/FS2- at the beginning of the week I asked you to keep a milk bottle, today we are going to turn your bottles into a bird house or bird feeding station.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ask an adult to help you cut a hole in your milk bottle about 2 inches from the bottom. 2. Ask an adult to help you make a small stick sized hole just below your bigger hole. Make sure it goes straight through the opposite side 3. Thread your stick through so there is enough room each side for a bird to perch on. 4. Fasten a piece of string around the lid and tie it securely. 5. Decorate your milk bottle. 6. Put some bread, crackers, nuts or bird seed in the bottom and hang it outside. 7. Watch to see how many birds come to enjoy their new home. <p>Please send me a picture of your bird feeders!</p>
