

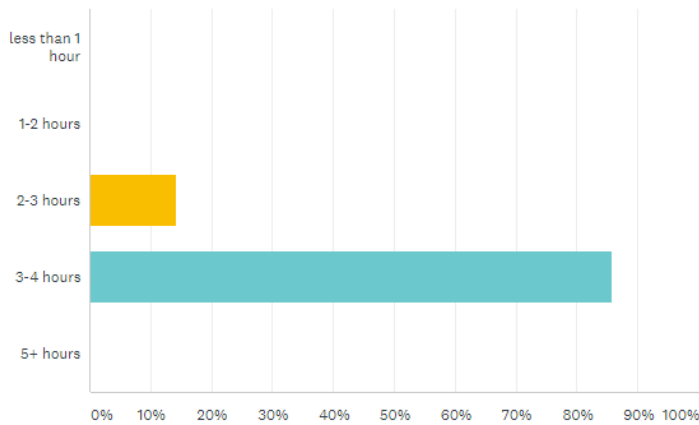

This was a FS2 child.



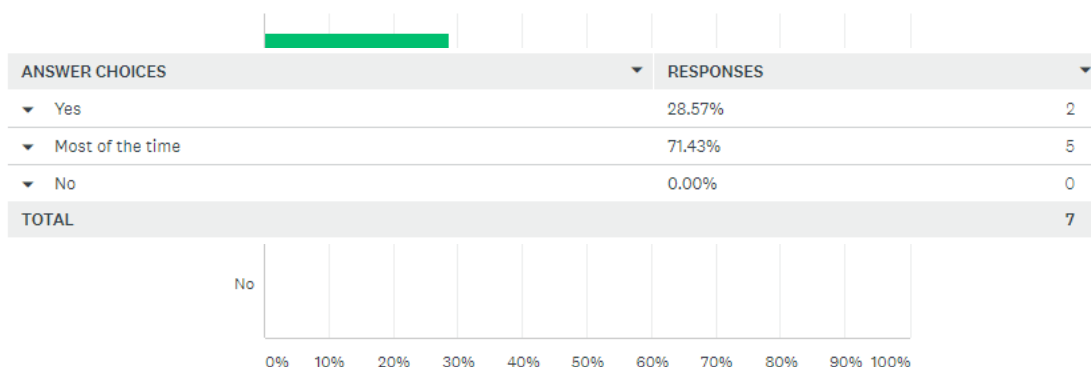

Is your child able to access the home learning independently?

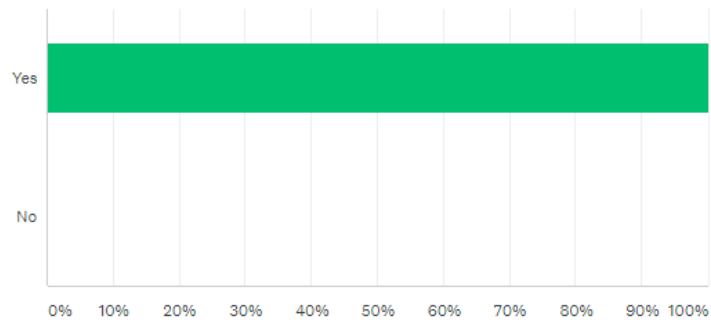

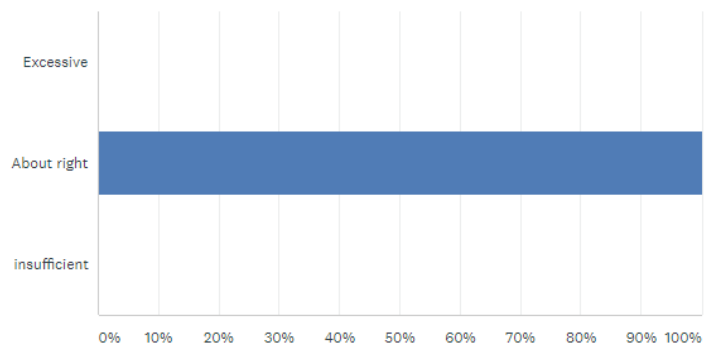

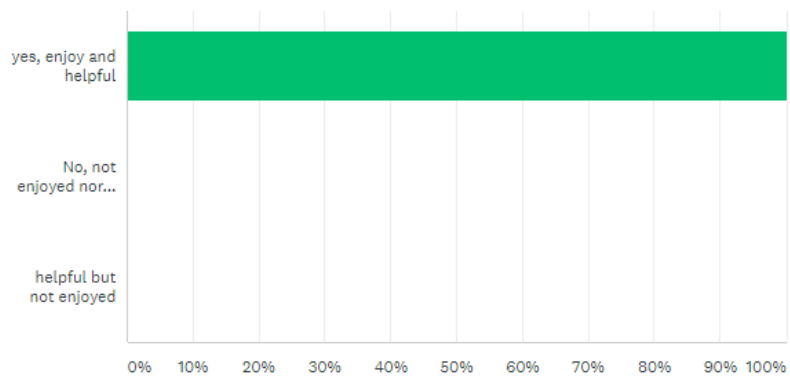

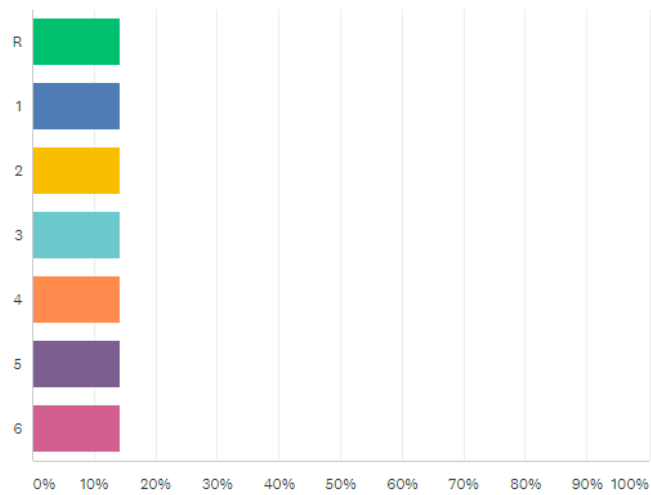
