



<p>Thursday 04.02.21.</p> 	 <p>Look at the Reading Comprehension questions document and answer the questions. Make sure you use full sentences and give evidence by using phrases such as 'I know this because...' or 'this is obvious when...'</p>	<p><u>SPaG:</u></p>  <p><u>History Writing:</u></p>  Write the middle part of your myth - focus on the problem(s) and how it/they are going to be overcome. Remember to use your plan and read back over the beginning of your story, to make sure it fits together. Again, this is just a draft.	<p>Today we are going to have a go at changing fractions into percentages. Don't forget to pause the video as directed but also if you need time to think about what they are saying.</p> <p>https://vimeo.com/492449530</p> <p>Just take it step by step, filling out the worksheet as you go.</p> <p><i>Something a little easier... Part of working out percentages involves dividing by 100. Roll a dice or make your own number cards to make 2/3/4 digit number then divide them by 100. For example:</i></p> <p><i>428 ÷ by 100 = 4.28!</i> <i>4927 ÷ 100 = 49.27</i> <i>Can you do 10 numbers.
