



<p>Tuesday 09.02.21.</p> 	<p><u>Ask questions to understand the text.</u> Highlight unknown words - what could they mean? Discuss: what the text is about? Anything of interest? Do you like it or not? Why? Annotate on the text thinking about how it should sound to the audience like we do in class. Can you read it to someone in your family? Give a performance.</p>  <p>Can you get someone in your home to do a performance with you? Decide who is reading which lines.</p>	<p>SPaG: Do the following SPaG activity</p>  <p>History Writing: Write the end part of your myth - look back over your previous story draft and plan to help you. Focus on the resolution - how was the problem solved and what has the character learned?
