

Additional comments and suggestions from Feedback Survey

'We have kept school routines, the children have told me the school rules (putting hand up, sitting at a table to work and having playtime and lunchtime. They even call me Miss) They love it. I'm very happy with how my children are getting on, lots of activities have been set, but a good balance of those that can be done independently and those that need starting off. A few need more adult help'.

'Really appreciate all the hard work that's gone into the work set, a nice even balance. I sometimes find the writing tasks harder as my child does not like writing and tries to get out of doing it. My child responds really well to the teacher's comments and will do anything for her, so I am finding that really helpful'.
