

How to make 3d pyramid

Equipment

Paper or cardboard





Pen or pencil

Ruler

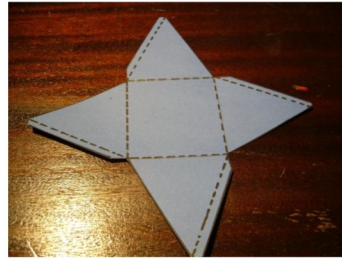
Scissors

Glue

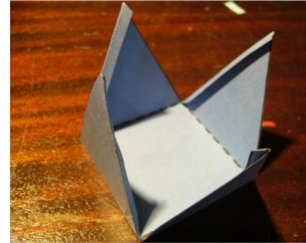
What you need to do

<p>1. Draw a large square that has sides of 18cm long.</p>	
<p>2. Create a grid of squares within the large square by making marks 6cm along each side and then joining them up like the image shows.</p>	
<p>3, Mark the middle of each side of the large square as shown in the image</p>	
<p>4. Draw the shape of the pyramid on the paper, Remember to guide yourself by the squares. Make sure you add the tabs too, which should be half a cm away from the original line. Take a close look at the picture.</p>	

5. Cut out the cardboard pyramid.



6. Fold all the dotted lines to create the tabs. Take a look at the picture to see how your pyramid should look at this stage.



7. Put glue on all the tabs on the pyramid.



8. Stick all the parts of the pyramid together with each tab and press so they stick firmly, You have now finished your paper pyramid.
