First you need to compare them and say if they are longer or shorter. Then choose something the same size to measure them with, like pasta or Lego, have a go at guessing how many bits of pasta or how many Lego bricks you will need to measure from one end to the other. <b>This is called an estimate, which is a sensible guess.</b></p>	<p>Look at your geography picture from Wednesday. Can you remind yourself what is human geography and what is physical geography?</p> <p>Now have a look at the sorting cards (<b>see attachment</b>) and see if you can sort them into human and physical piles.</p> <p>If you are unable to print them out draw two large boxes, one for human, one for physical and then either write the words in the box or draw the pictures in the correct box.</p>
