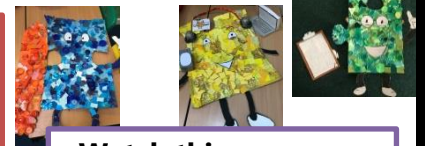
We have only been in school for four days this week but there is so much going on. In every class I visit the children are engaged in their learning, happy and full of interesting questions.

Jacob from Amethyst, for contributing so many fabulous sentences to the classroom Reading working wall.

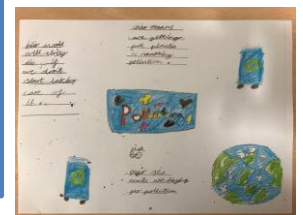
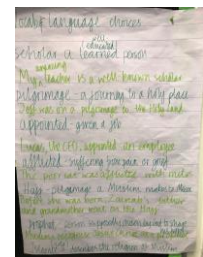
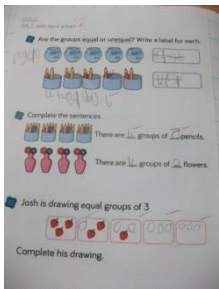
Lincoln in Opal class for his improved growth mindset and independence, especially with his writing.
