- Go for a walk and try and identify some common plants you may find in your garden or local area
- Plant some seeds and watch them grow and record what happens
 - Create a bunch of flowers out of paper and straws
 - Construct a bug house and see if anything moves in
 - Create a picture of a plant cycle
 - Try printing with different materials
- Research how habitats are different for different animals
