**Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September**

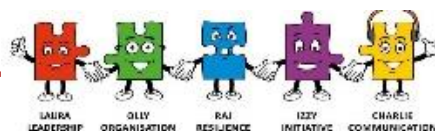
