Welcome back to autumn term 2!

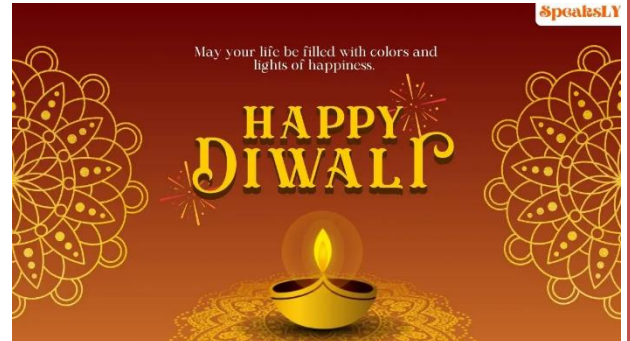
The focus this term in all classes is science, please check out the school website class pages for lots of useful information about what your child is learning this term and engage in the homework activities, which all support the learning in school.

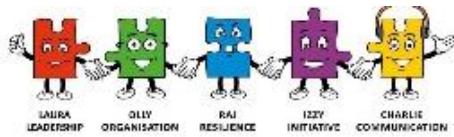
