Have a wonderful, safe weekend and keep warm.

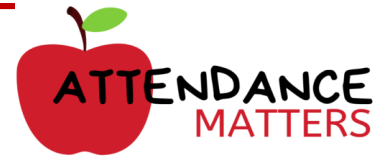
