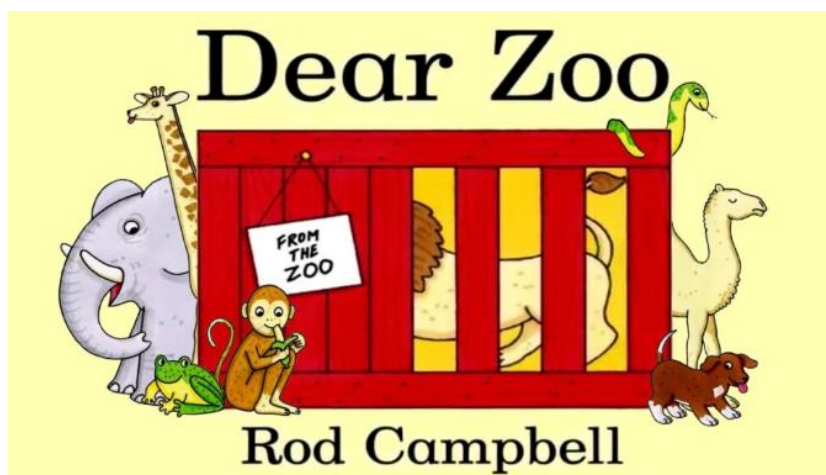


Home learning in Fox
