

## Home learning in Fox

Please try to read with and to your child daily. Try to encourage enjoyment in reading by reading different types of books - we have lots of books in the school library that the children bring home each week.

We would also like the year 1 children to spend time practising reading and spelling the statutory words for Year 1 - these are available on our website. We recommend concentrating on 5 at a time. Learning their bonds to 10 (finding different ways of making 10) is also a really important skill for the year 1 children - see the homework suggestion for developing this skill below.



We also have some optional home learning linked to our topic question 'what can I discover as a time traveller?':

- Design and draw a picture of what you think a time machine could look like.
- Research facts about dinosaurs. Which is your favourite?
- Write a list of what you would take into space if you were going to be travelling for over a year.
- Make a model of a medieval castle. You could use lego or cardboard or something else.
- Write down all the different ways to make 10 - you could show this using numbers or pictures. Here is a picture to help.
